REGISTRATION FEE

- 1 Little Kickers: born 2008 - \$110
- 2 Soccer Fun: born 2006-2007 - \$120
- 3 Single Club Registration \$180 - all other divisions
- 4 Family Rate: For 3 or more children in the same family, deduct \$20 per player.
- 5 Rep Fees: In addition to club registration fees, 2 post-dated cheques. U9-U10 \$275. U11 & older \$350. Submit to Team Managers by Feb 15.
- 6 Fee Assistance - Speak to one of our cashiers and they will direct you further. Waterloo Residents Only.

REFUND POLICY

- 1 Full refund until April 16th.
- 2 50% refund after April 16th.
- 3 NO REFUND after May 14th.
- 4 \$20.00 administration fee will apply to all refunds and any programming change.

PAYMENT

- Cheques made payable to Waterloo Minor Soccer. Cash accepted. Visa & Debit-RIM only.

- Registration forms returned by mail must be postmarked by **March 1, 2012**

- NSF Cheques – A \$20 fee will be charged. Player will be placed on a team only after the fee has been paid in full, and if space is still available.

VOLUNTEERS

Please fill in the "PLEASE HELP US" section of the registration form. We expect over 4,500 boys and girls to register this year. Approximately 975 volunteers are needed to coach, convene and manage the teams. Training is provided.

Please dress children appropriately. Games are cancelled for lightning only by convener/referee.

UNIFORMS

Each registered player receives a complete uniform (shirt, shorts and socks). **For safety, soccer shoes and shin pads are mandatory for all divisions. Soccer Fun & Little Kickers - shin pads only.**
