Representative Travel Team Head Coaches must have, and/or commit to obtaining, all three levels of the Ontario Soccer Association (OSA) Community Coach Certificate for the 2011 playing year. These coaching level courses are offered in the Fall and Winter months in the Waterloo Region area and require approximately 3 non-consecutive weekends to complete.
